Message from Pastor Gus

Our Charting the Course process is coming to a close. Our team that includes Jane Lamb, Dottie and Jerry Leach, Alma Ruth Michael, Steve Moore, Jennifer Rabalais, R.C. Owen and I has nearly concluded its work. We are now in the final stage to submit our recommendations for approval to committees like the finance committee and our church council. I would have thought when we started this process that, at this point, we would have a longer list of things we would dream our congregation accomplishing; however, we believe led to focus on fewer objectives but do those objectives well. It's the old adage that sometimes less is really more.

One recommendation is for our people to participate in a spiritual assessment. No doctor will prescribe medication or surgery until they have first made careful examination. Construction doesn't begin for a building until the ground on which the building will stand is tested for appropriate drainage and other necessary qualities. We believe for our church's spiritual health a spiritual assessment is crucial. We believe that each person, whether member or a person who regularly worships here, needs to participate in the assessment. The purpose of a spiritual assessment is to help each person have a better understanding of their strengths and weaknesses in their relationship with God and the church. Sometimes we either overestimate or underestimate our strengths and weaknesses. The assessment might provide insights we miss. Through this assessment, we can also better plan future ministries that can Scripture says, 1 Thess. strengthen our people's faith. 5:22"Test all thing and hold fast to that which is good." We believe the time has come to make a closer examination of our relationship with God so we can better pursue his purpose and leading among us.
